## (GENESIS 29:1-30)

### Geheue VERSE:

*"Iemand wat vir ander mense goed is, sal self die vrugte daarvan pluk. Iemand wat niks vir ander omgee nie, vernietig homself. 'n Skurk se optrede bring min lewensvreugde. Wie vir ander mense omgee, se lewe sal vol blydskap wees."*

### OMSIRKEL DIE REGTE WOORDE:

- 1 Gén 29:10 "Toe Jakob vir (REBEKKA / RAGEL / RAGAB), die dogter van sy ma se broer Laban, sien met haar pa se (KOEIE / KLEINVEE / KAMELE), het Jakob nader gekom en die (STOMP / KLIP / DEKSEL) van die put af weggerol en Laban se (KAMELE / HOENDERS / BEESTE / KLEINVEE) laat suip."
- 2 Gén 29:20 "Jakob het toe (10 jaar / 3 jaar / 7 jaar) gewerk vir Ragel, en dit was vir hom soos (jare / maande / 'n paar dae), want hy het haar liefgehad.

### VUL DIE ONTBREKENDE WOORDE IN:

- 3 Gén 29:16 "Laban het twee dogters gehad. Die oudste was \_\_\_\_\_ en die jongste \_\_\_\_\_.

### WAAR OF VALS?:

- 4 Lea het sagte oë gehad, maar Ragel was mooi gebou. Sy was beeldskoon. (Gén 29:17)  
**WAAR of VALS?**
- 5 Jakob het haar liefgehad en hy het vir Laban gesê: "Ek sal sewe jaar vir u werk vir u jongste dogter Ragel." (Gén 29:18)  
**WAAR of VALS?**

### EKSTRA INLIGTING:

- 6 Lea se naam beteken "Uitgeput" – sy was seker maar gereeld moeg. Ragel se naam beteken "Ooitjie" – en sy het die kleinvee (skape / bokke) opgepas.
- 7 Laban het nie alles vir Jakob gesê nie, daarom het Jakob nie geweet van die gebruik dat die oudste dogter eerste moet trou voor die ander dogter mag trou nie. Dink jy Jakob sou anders opgetree het as hy daarvan geweet het?  
**GENESIS 29:25**
- 8 Dit lyk nie of Ragel ook 'n groot trou onthaal gehad het nie. Vir die Bybelskrywer was dit net belangrik om te sê dat Jakob en Ragel uiteindelik met mekaar getroud is. **GENESIS 29:28**
- 9 Jakob het binne een maand nada thy vir Ragel gesien het, gevra om met haar te trou. **GENESIS 29:14 en 18**

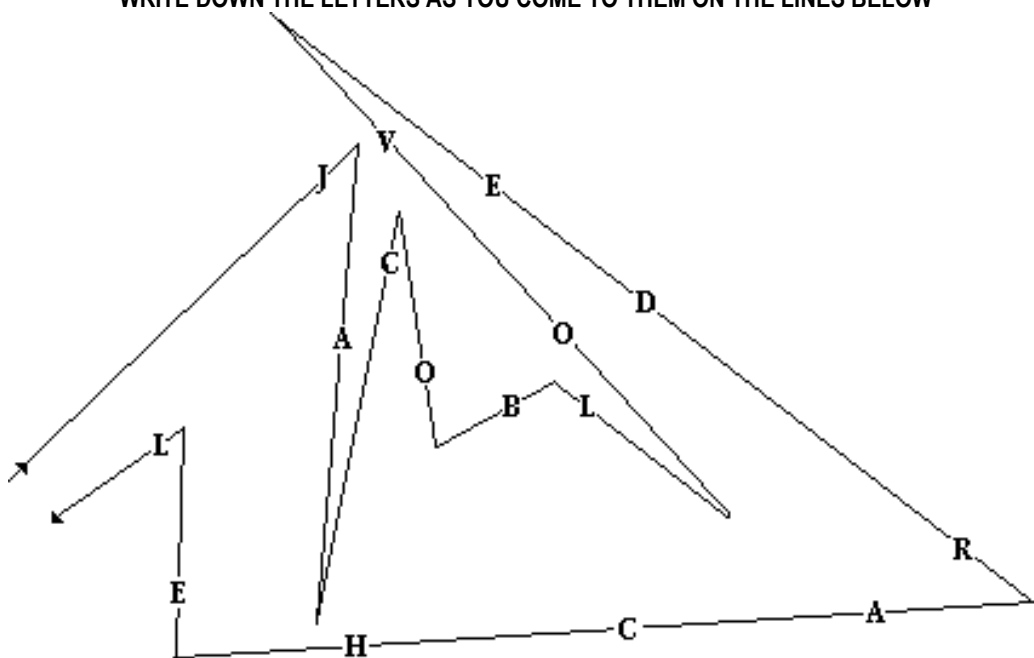

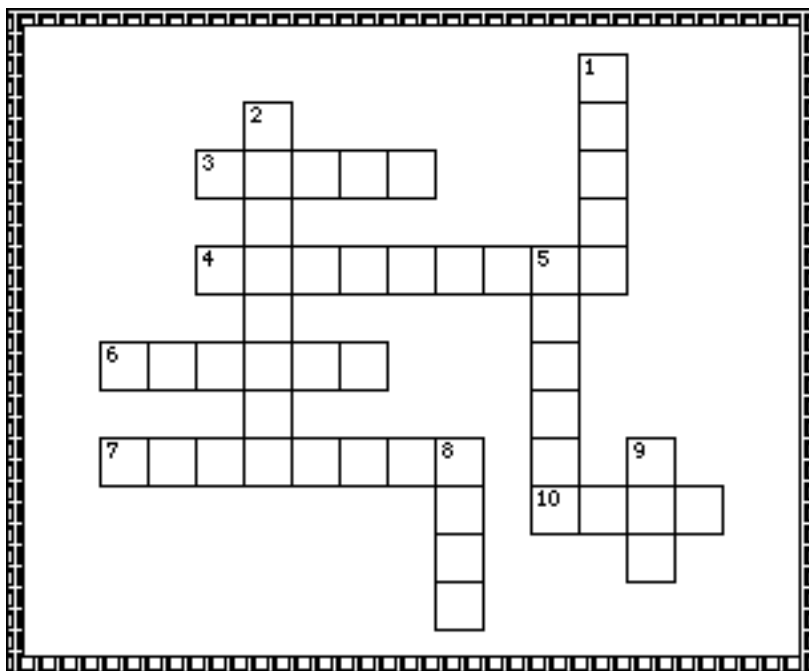

## 25. LEAH & RACHEL (GENESIS 29:1-30)



- 6 ACROSS "The wicked man does deceptive work, but to him who sows righteousness will be a sure \_\_\_\_\_. " **PROVERBS 11:18**
- 5 DOWN "And it came to pass, when Jacob saw \_\_\_\_\_ the daughter of Laban his mother's brother, and the sheep of Laban his mother's brother, that Jacob went near and rolled the stone from the well's mouth, and watered the flock of Laban his mother's brother." **GENESIS 29:10**
- 9 DOWN "And Jacob told Rachel that he was her father's relative and that he was Rebekah's son. So she \_\_\_\_\_ and told her father." **GENESIS 29:12**
- 10 ACROSS "Now Laban had two daughters: the name of the elder was \_\_\_\_\_, and the name of the younger was Rachel." **GENESIS 29:16**
- 2 DOWN "Leah's eyes were \_\_\_\_\_, but Rachel was beautiful of form and appearance." **GENESIS 29:17**
- 3 ACROSS "Now Jacob loved Rachel; and he said, 'I will \_\_\_\_\_ you seven years for Rachel your younger daughter.' " **GENESIS 29:18**
- 8 DOWN "So Jacob served seven years for Rachel, and they seemed but a few \_\_\_\_\_ to him because of the love he had for her." **GENESIS 29:20**
- 7 ACROSS When Laban tricked Jacob into marrying his older daughter Leah, Jacob asked, "What is this you have done to me? Was it not for Rachel that I served you? Why then have you \_\_\_\_\_ me?" **GENESIS 29:25**
- 4 ACROSS "And Laban said, 'It must not be done so in our country, to give the younger before the \_\_\_\_\_.'" **GENESIS 29:26**
- 1 DOWN Now Jacob "loved Rachel more than Leah. And he served with Laban still another \_\_\_\_\_ years." **GENESIS 29:30**
